Key Stage 1 SATs results

Key stage 1 teacher assessment and tests cover:

- reading
- writing
- SPAG (spelling, punctuation, and grammar)
- maths
- science

At Ss Peter and Paul our Key Stage tests take place in Year 2 in May. Your child's teacher will use your child's work (including spoken work and homework) to assess what level your child is at in each of these areas above. In addition to this your child will undertake some more formal tests. These are integrated into the school day, assessments are spread out over a period of time, and teachers try to work them into the normal routine in such a way that students may not feel like they're being tested. Changes to assessment in September 2015 directed teachers to assess children without levels. Government guidelines identify as child working at the Expected Level (EXS) if they have achieved age related expectations. A child who has exceeded age related expectations is assessed as working at greater depth (GDS). Children who have not achieved age related expectations are assessed as 'Working towards the standard' (WTS) or working below the Key stage standard (BLW, PKF, PKE, PKG).
