

Music at Bede Burn ...the strongest form of magic.



We love to sing and take advantage of every opportunity to do so: to support learning, to perform together both for the pleasure of others and for our own enjoyment. We hold several annual events, including our Christmas carol concert, Sing Up Day celebrations, Key Stage productions and our Grandparents' concert. Our school choir 'Beat Burn' have a hectic calendar, performing in and around school, to pupils and families and to wider audiences, from local churches to Durham Cathedral.

Programmes of study are integrated into class projects to provide a real context for learning for example listening to music associated with our topic be it pieces from the past, synthesised sounds or popular tunes. Children can then compose their own piece of music including elements explored.

Pupils also have the opportunity to extend their skills and apply their knowledge through music sessions led by qualified musicians.



EYFS Expressive arts and design

This involves supporting children to explore and play with a wide range of media and materials. It involves providing children with opportunities and encouragement for sharing their thoughts, ideas and feelings through a variety of activities in art, music, movement, dance and role play.
