Research shows that the first few years of teacher development are the most crucial. That's why our highly supportive Newly Qualified Teacher (NQT) programme aims to develop knowledge, understanding and confidence, supporting NQTs with a range of practical strategies and techniques to help them survive the first year of teaching.

Our programme is delivered cross-phase and cross-subject and is facilitated by expert practitioners and SLEs from the primary and secondary sector. Four professional learning sessions (at a range of days and times to ease pressure on cover requirements) will cover all areas of the new DfE Early Career Framework, and will include opportunities to observe great teaching in practice and meet with ITT and RQTs to build personal support networks. Areas covered will include:

- behaviour management and climate for learning
- pedagogy and how to put this into practice
- curriculum
- assessment
- professional behaviours and resilience

**All sessions will be based at The King Edward VI School; local First and Middle schools will host observations to ensure specialist input.**

- Session 2: Wednesday 5th February 2020 - 08:00-12:00
- Session 3: Friday 3rd April 2020 - 08:00-11:00
- Session 4: Tuesday 5th May 2020 - 15:00-18:00

As well as providing continued support in the form of relevant practical and useful professional development opportunities the programme will also provide participants with invaluable opportunities to network with other NQTs and RQTs across the region.
