



Residential Trips 2017 - 18

Each year the children in years 4 to 6 are invited to join their peers and teachers on a 2 night residential trip. The purpose of these residential trips is to allow children a chance to have new experiences and develop their sense of independence. It also allows those who don't always shine academically to find areas that they can excel in outside of the classroom. All our residential trips risk assessments are signed off by South Tyneside Council, who also provide our insurance. The children are always accompanied by school staff and all instructors are fully qualified and DBS checked.

We always like to give parents 6 months notice of a residential trip in order to allow them to spread out the cost of the trip. Payment cards are available from the office for those who wish to pay in instalments. If you require financial assistance please speak with Mr Conway.

This year we have the following trips planned:

Year 4 (October 2017) - Boggle Hole YHA, Nr Whitby, North Yorkshire.

This is a beach based activity holiday. The YHA staff will be running the activities which include rock pooling, beach art and treasure hunting.

Year 5 (February 2018) - Alex Rider Spy Academy, Grinton Lodge YHA, North Yorkshire.

This trip is based on the Alex Rider books and the children will be taking part in outdoor activities led by the YHA staff.

Year 6 (May 2018) - Borrowdale, Lake District, Cumbria.

This is an outward bound adventure trip. The activities are lead by the staff from Live4Adventure and the children will stay in the YHA at Borrowdale.

More information regarding costs and payment dates will be sent out in letter 6 months before the date of travel.
