

Instrument of Government

Holy Trinity Church of England Primary School, NW3

1. The name of the school is "Holy Trinity Church of England Primary School, NW3".
2. The school is a Voluntary Aided School.
3. The name of the governing body is "The governing body of Holy Trinity Church of England Primary School, NW3".
4. The governing body shall consist of
 - a) 2 Parent Governors
 - b) 1 Local Authority Governor
 - c) 2 Staff Governors, including the Head Teacher
 - d) 7 foundation governors
5. The total number of governors shall be 12.
6. Foundation governors are appointed as follows
 - a) 2 by the London Diocesan Board of Schools
 - b) 2 by the PCC of Holy Trinity Church, NW3
 - c) 2 by the North Camden Deanery Synod
7. Foundation governor – Ex Officio
 - a) The holder of the following office shall be a foundation governor ex-officio: Vicar of Holy Trinity Church, NW3.
 - b) The Archdeacon of Hampstead shall be entitled to appoint a foundation governor to act in the place of the ex-officio governor whose governorship derives from the office named in (a) above, in the event that that ex-officio governor is unable or unwilling to act as a foundation governor, or has been removed from office under regulation 23 (2) of the Regulations.
8. The Archdeacon of Hampstead shall be entitled to request the governing body to remove the ex-officio foundation governor referred to in 7(a) above and to appoint any substitute governor.
9. A trust deed exists for the school.
10. Ethos statement.
 - a) Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan level.
 - b) The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian beliefs and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith, and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.
11. The term of office of all appointed governors is four years except:
 - a) The Staff Governor who is not the Head Teacher, for whom the term of office has been agreed, through consultation, to be one year.
12. This instrument of governance comes into effect on 29th June 2015.
13. This instrument was made by order of the London Borough of Camden Local Education Authority on 8th May 2015.

14. A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and Head Teacher if not a governor), any trustees and to the London Diocesan Board for Schools.
