We actively build effective working relationships with stakeholders within the local community and beyond, implement social and emotional aspects of learning, and promote diversity and shared values whilst challenging Islamophobia, Anti-Semitism and other prejudices. Additionally, staff have already received intensive training by the Prevent Team of Northumbria Police to ensure that we are protecting our young people from being drawn into terrorism by having a robust safeguarding policy in place to identify children at risk, and intervening as appropriate.
