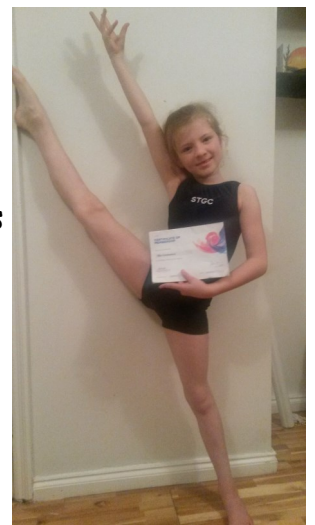
Please remember that dinner money must be paid each Monday.
