End of term arrangement and start of the new school year

I am writing to update you on our recent Progression Week activities and outline arrangements for the end of term and start of the new school year. Below are some key dates for the end of term and Sep 2019 start.

Year 12 Progression Week

I am pleased to report that Year 12 Progression Week was well attended and a huge success. Students were given the opportunity to meet with guest speakers from the fields of University, careers and apprenticeships, in addition to beginning UCAS registration, attending a University visit and a UCAS conference.

Students have now met with the Sixth Form Team and put together an action plan for the summer, which should include drafting a personal statement, visiting Universities and attending open days. Students should also be researching University courses in detail to ensure that modules taught are suited to their subject preferences and skills in addition to exploring apprenticeship and degree apprenticeships. Students will be assigned a meeting with the schools HE upon their return to Sixth Form in September.

Any students who missed Progression Week activities due to being on work experience, can access materials and information on the Year 12 Google Classroom. This information will also be available for parents/guardians on the school website.

UCAS applications

UCAS applications open from September 1 2019, with students required to meet the deadlines below:

- Oxbridge/Med/Dentistry application submission deadline is 15 October 2019
- Internal Russell Group deadline is 1 November 2019
- Final submission date to UCAS is 15th January 2019

We would like all students to make an application to University. In addition, they may also wish to submit applications to degree apprenticeships and alternative apprenticeship schemes. From September students will

be working with tutors, the HE advisor and the Sixth Form team with our UCAS advisor Ms Coxon to discuss personal statements and options.

Priority for first appointments will be given to students needing to meet the 1 October deadline.

Examination results and Progression to Year 13 meetings

End of year examination results will be published this Thursday 12 July. Results have already been communicated to students and any boys who are required to resit an exam have now been informed. As previously stated students will attend their progression into Year 13 meeting on July 18/19 with a member of the Senior or Sixth Form Team. During this meeting a decision on progression into Year 13 will be made based on results (minimum D grade), attendance and attitude, as well as a decision about on-going subject pathways. Attendance at this meeting is essential. Meeting times will be confirmed with students on collection of results.
