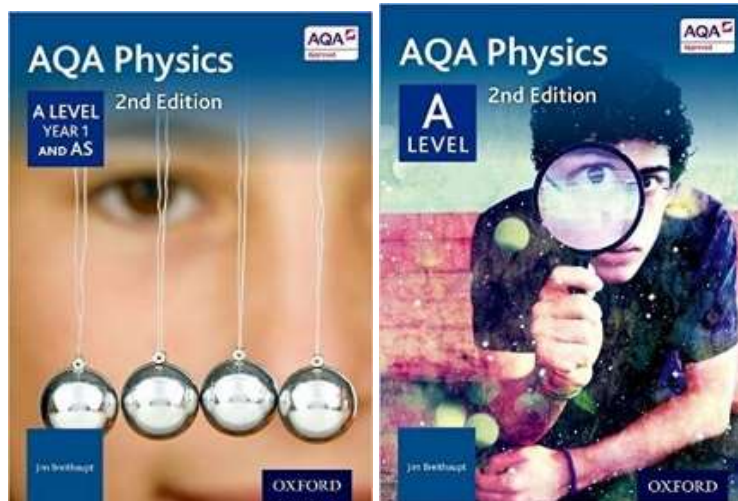


Physics Summer Task
