



A LEVEL COMPUTER SCIENCE INDEPENDENT STUDY

- Have a copy of the A Level Computer Science specification with the learning objectives and outcomes in your subject folder
- Have dividers for each topic and on the first page have a glossary of keywords for that topic
- For each topic covered have evidence of range of questions attempted and improved
- For each topic, evidence of past paper questions and classwork
- On your computer at home, create a record of useful websites on each topic in organised folders in Favourites
- Watch relevant videos on Youtube on each topic to review and clarify your understanding and use to add to your class notes
- Subscribe to channels on Computer science and Universities that share lectures and short videos
- Visit online learning sites like Udemy, data camp, Khan academy, edx and future learn that offer courses to enhance your understanding, knowledge and skills. They further offer you real world experiences to build a portfolio that can be referenced in university interviews and job/apprenticeship placements
- Re-read chapters of topics covered in class and always read ahead
- Practice consistently and revise regularly so you are familiar with your work on a fortnightly basis
