



A LEVEL FRENCH INDEPENDENT LEARNING ACTIVITIES

- Watch the news channel France 24 at least twice a week and sum up in French or English (you can alternate) <http://www.france24.com/fr/> or/and <http://www.TV5monde.fr/>
- Read one article a week and summarise it in French in the magazine Le Kiosque des Lycéens where you can access LKDL on Y12 Google classroom all articles on French and Francophone culture, literature, history, geography, sport, music and many other topics. <http://www.lekiosquenumerique.com/lycee/11>
- Use the exam board materials to create an example of a type of question you might get on topic being studied
- Learn a couple of higher level structures/idiomatic expressions (debate booklet) and 5 new words each week
- Decide on a topic/theme/film/book you would like to **do for your** research project you will present for your oral exam. Do some research and start gathering information and evidence you will use. Guidance see AQA exemplars Research Project
- Revise irregular verbs in all tenses and past participles (grammar section in your folder)
- Read the novel "Sac de Billes" (studied in lessons) and other books/novels (see list on AQA website)
- Keep a folder of current news stories on the topics studied but also any topics on the exam list
- Look at sample exam questions and the mark scheme, attempt question yourself AQA website
- Look at exemplar questions and read examiners feedback
