

Impact of 2017 / 2018 Sport Premium Funding Spend

- In the academic year 2017-2018, we asked children what they thought the Sport Premium funding could be used for in our school. Feedback suggested that the children would like different after-school activities. In response to this, we ran a KS1 gymnastic after school club and KS2 basketball after school club at no charge to the children.
- **100% of pupils participated in a Sainsbury's School Games sports festival** again this year (Reception, Year 1, Year 2, Year 3 and Year 4, Year 5 and Year 6).
- Year 6 entered league and cup competitions for which they received extra lunch-time coaching.
- Year 2 and Year 4 took part in the Skipping Festival Project at St Joseph's Academy, competing against other primary schools from South Tyneside; again, **increasing pupil participation in competitive school sport**. Both year groups **took part in specialised training** in the lead up to the events. Individuals and groups of children won many Bronze, Silver and Gold Awards. The cost of this was £675.
- All children in school took part in a whole school PE day to **raise the profile of sport and physical activity** and took part in wake up shake up exercises and a dance-a-thon. The junior classes also enjoyed **some specialist team-building coaching** and OAA activities with Andy Siddle from BOutdoors and Grass Roots Sports coaches, both of which were very popular. The cost of these activities was £210.
- All children took part in a competitive sports day with medals being awarded for first three teams.
- Year 6 were trained as Young Leaders through the Playmaker Award coaching, to **increase participation in sport and physical activity during playtimes and lunchtimes**.
- Equipment was also purchased to develop a more active playground.

The total spend from Sport Premium for this year was: £7760.24
