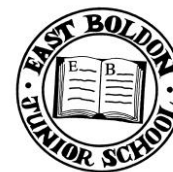

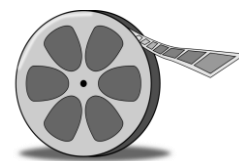
Child Safety Reminders:
