

Two Year Old Childcare

Funded Places for Two Year Old's

Your child may be entitled to a free early education place if you are in receipt of the following benefits:

- Universal credit
- Income support
- Employment and support allowance – income related (ESA(IR))
- Income based jobseeker's allowance
- The guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Support under part V1 of the immigration and asylum act 1999
- Child tax credit and / or working tax credit AND have an annual income below a specific threshold; (threshold – a household income of £16,190)
- Fostering allowance (paid for the child)
- You have a child for whom you have special guardianship, residence order or a child arrangement order.
- Disability living allowance (claimed for the child).

We offer five sessions per week. Parents can chose from a morning or an afternoon session depending upon availability.

Private funded places for Two Year Old's

We offer a limited number of places which parents can buy. This includes 3 hour sessions of a morning or an afternoon; or full days which can include breakfast, lunch or tea if required.

We advise that young children should attend at least 3 sessions per week for their well-being. This helps them to build relationships with key workers and their peers, it helps them to understand the routines and become familiar with the learning environment.
