EYFS Data

The Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) framework sets standards for the learning, development and care of children from birth to 5 years old. At the end Reception, the progress of pupils is assessed against the Early Learning Goals.

Children achieve a 'Good Level of Development' when they meet Early Learning Goals in the following 7 developmental areas: Personal, Social and Emotional Development; Physical Development; Communication and Language; Literacy Development and Mathematical Development.

In 2019, the children at St Anne's school achieved above the national average for achieving a 'Good Level of Development'. Children achieve above the national average for exceeding a 'Good Level of Development' at the end of Reception . Through a rich learning environment and excellent teaching, many of our children exceed national expectations.
