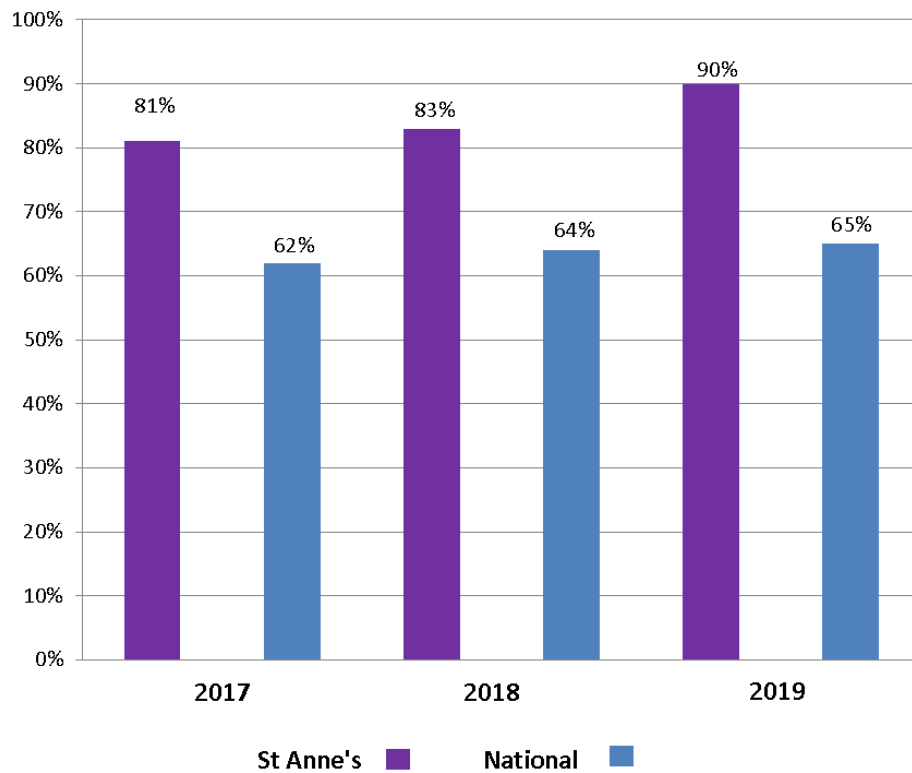
Many of our children exceeded the expected standard and are working at greater depth in all subjects.

All children at St Anne's school are exceptionally well equipped and prepared both academically and socially and emotionally for secondary school. This quality is recognised by both parents and secondary schools.

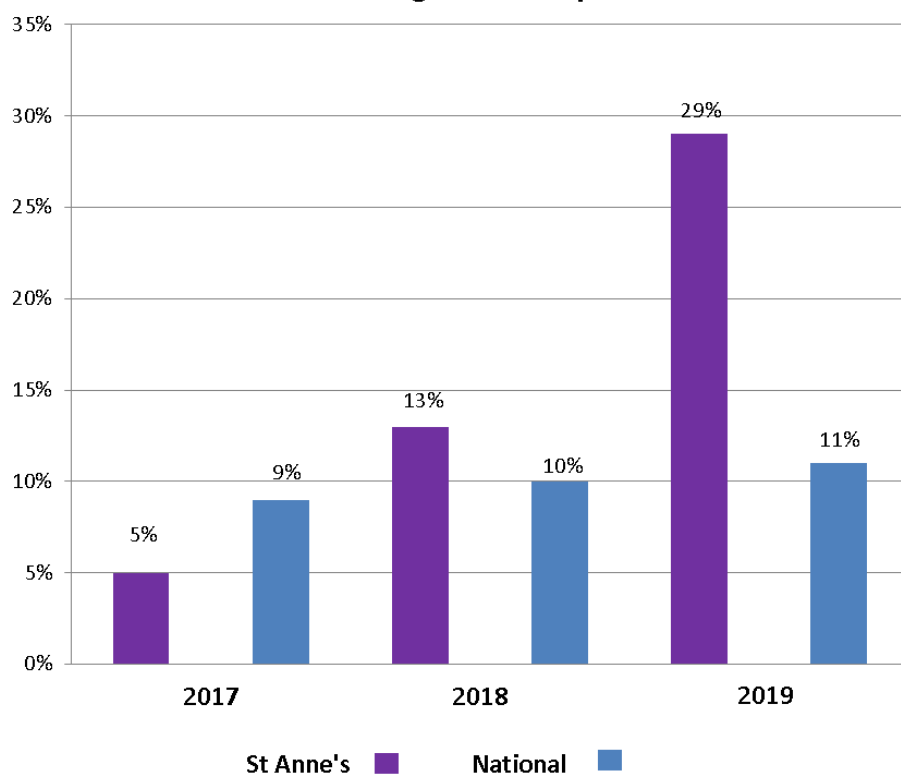
The charts below show how well children s at St Anne's are achieving compared to other primary schools in the country.

**% Achieving Expected Standard**

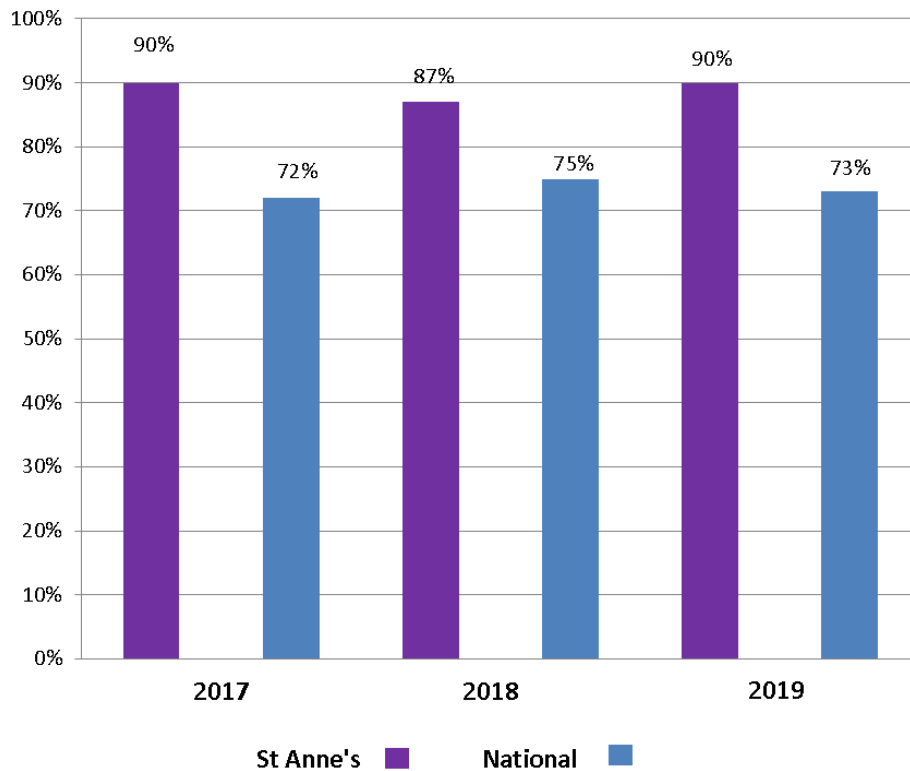


**KS2 RWM**  
**% Achieving Greater Depth**

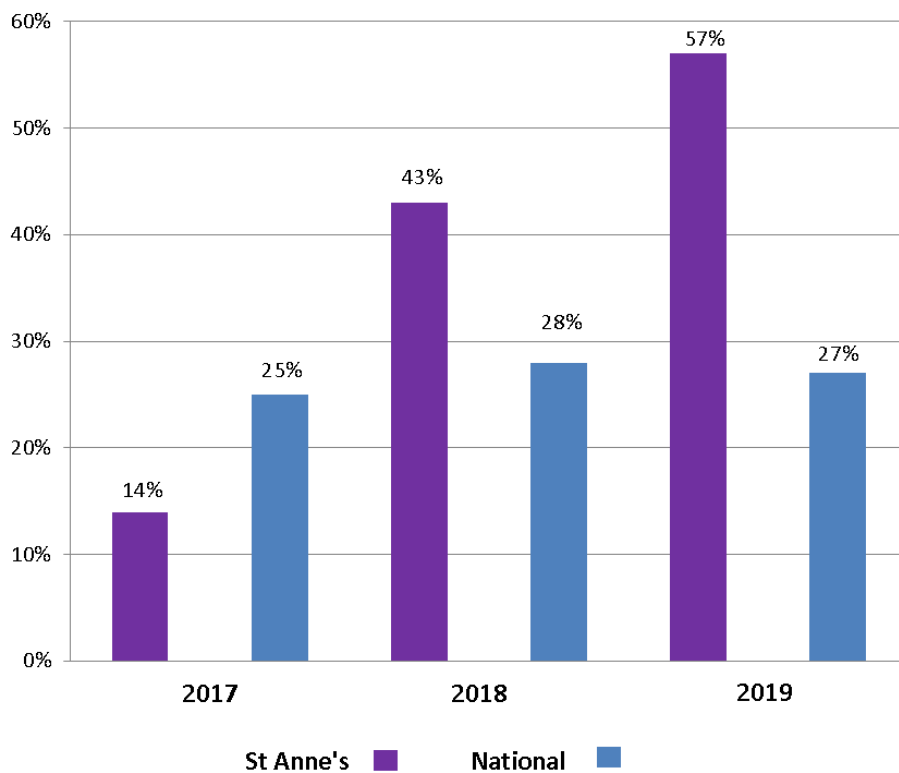

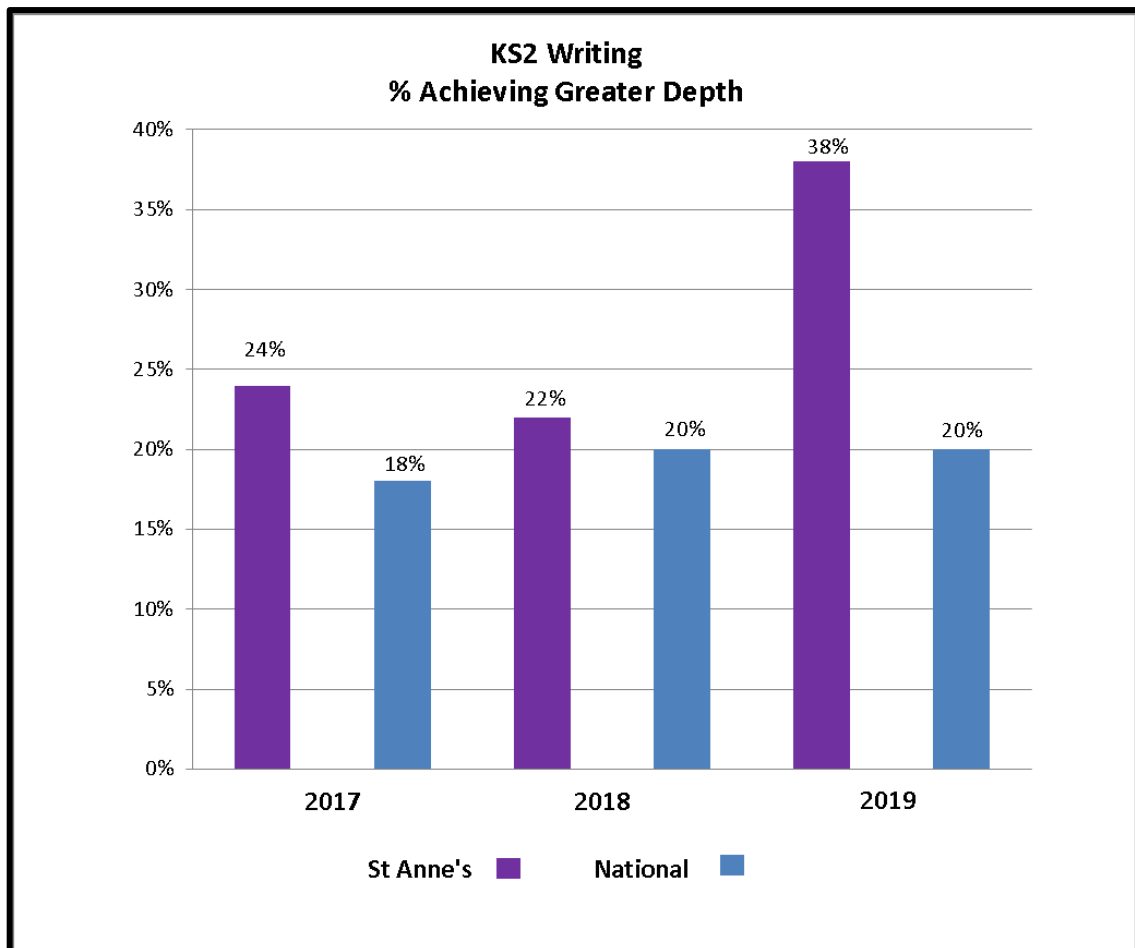
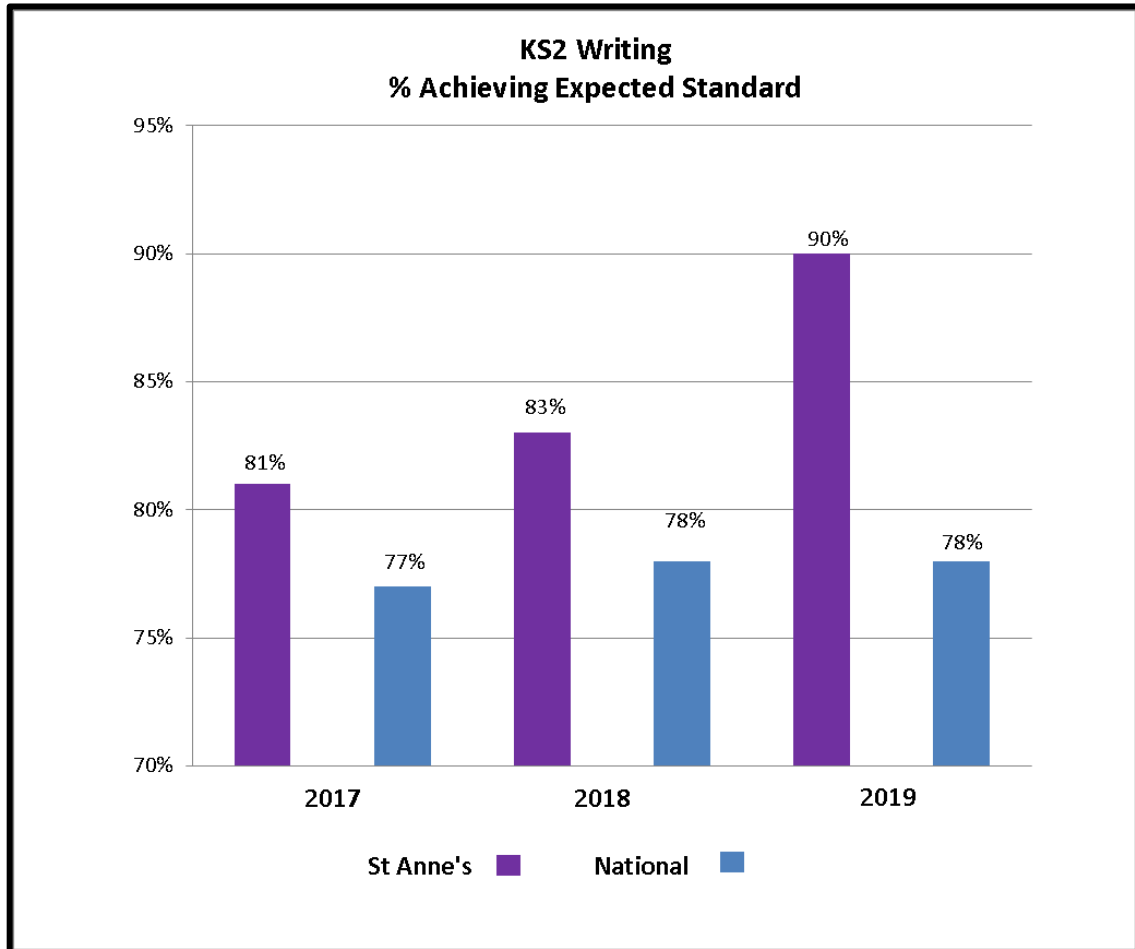
### KS2 Reading % Achieving Expected Standard



### KS2 Reading % Achieving Greater Depth

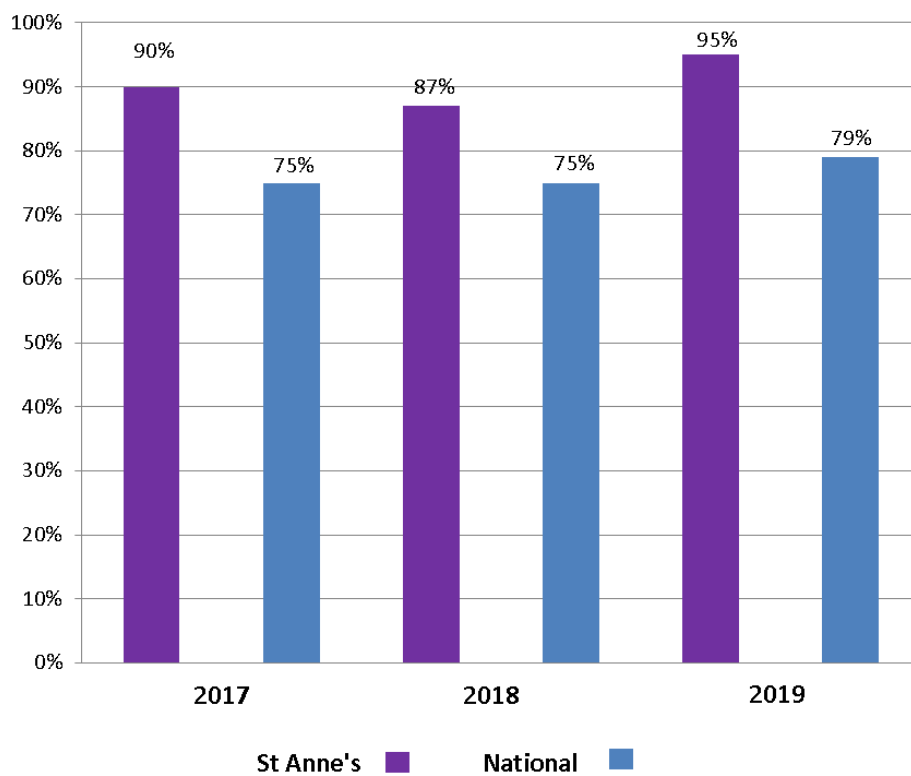

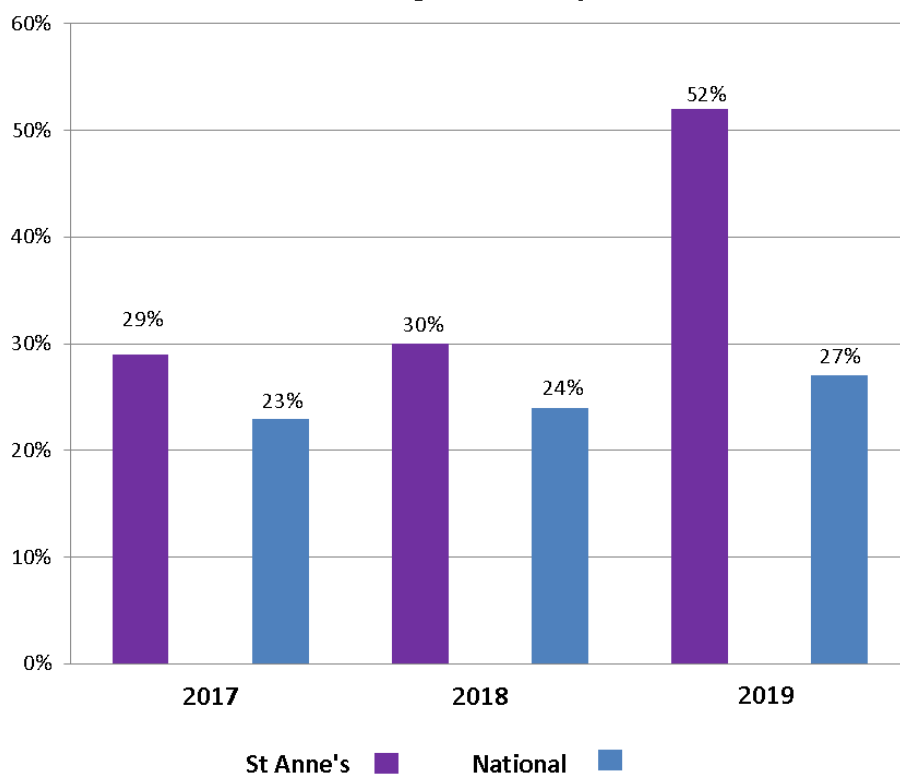

### KS2 Maths % Achieving Expected Standard

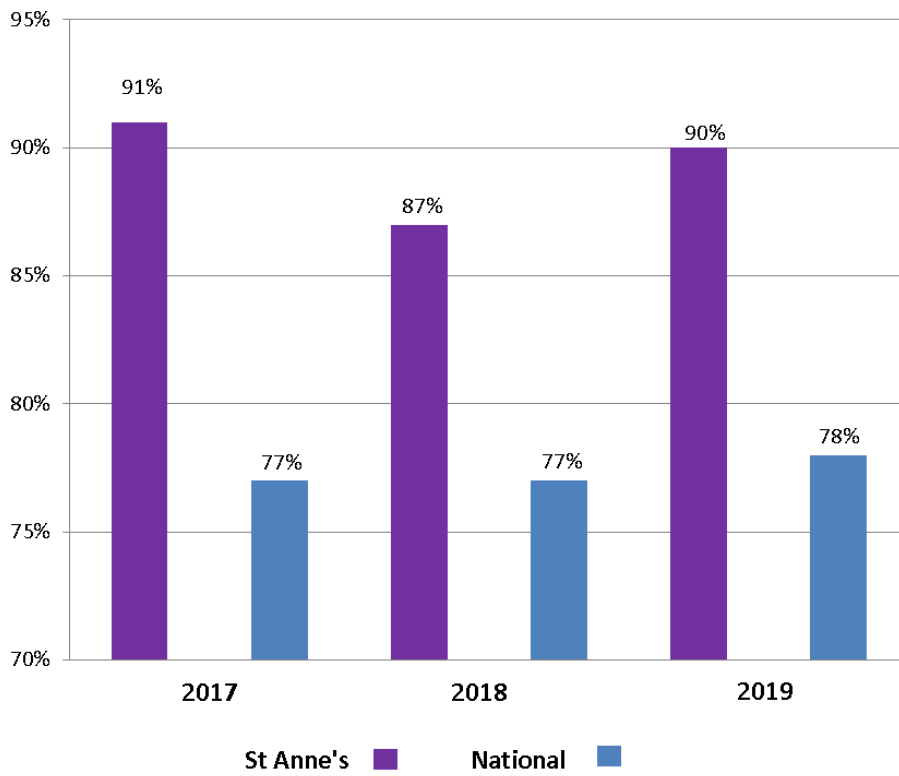
