| Increased club provision  | -More opportunities for children to attend clubs. Club participation has been raised to 82% with ALL children being given the opportunity to join at least one sport club. The school has achieved the Sainsbury's Gold Games Award.   |
| Gymnastics lessons within the curriculum with specialist PE teacher | -All pupils have received a programme of high quality gymnastic sessions with specialist teacher. Children across the school are more confident with the gymnastic skills. All class teachers have received a $\frac{1}{2}$ term CPD programme of jointly planned & taught sessions. |
| Emphasis 'Mr Raw's Fruit and Veg' challenge                         | - More children are beginning to make healthier choices and try something new! The bigger emphasis on this challenge and the fruit basket prize has been successful this year.   |
| Lead the Way in PE  | -More children have been given the chance to become involved in leading throughout PE and games lessons. This has been recorded on leadership charts.  |
| Gymnastics Club   | -Gymnastics club has further developed their skills learnt in class. They have become 'gymnastic experts' within class and this has boosted their confidence.  |
| Rock Challenge Dance Club   | -this club has increased the children's confidence and taught life skills including good organisation and dedication. The school has been represented at two national events.  |
