Bushcraft Camping Trip

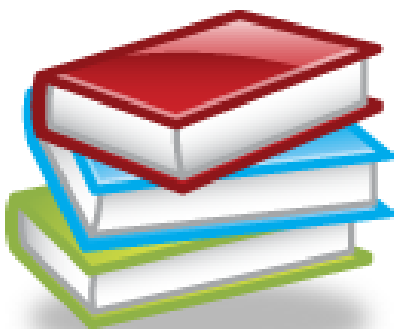
It is not long now until we are going away on our fantastic trip into the wilderness of Hatfield. Don't forget the meeting on

Thursday 23rd May (5:30-6:00pm) to confirm all of the final details.



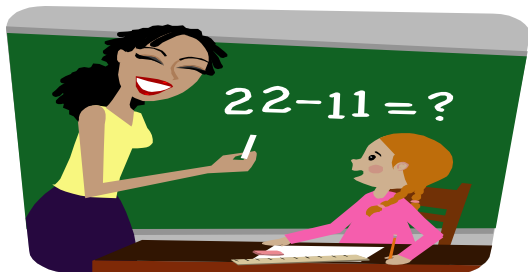
English and Maths
