Provision for Key Stage 4 and Sixth Form Students

The 14-19 curriculum we provide enables students to:

- Be involved in all stages of learning experience i.e. planning, doing and reviewing.
- Work in an environment that is suitable to age and reflects the activities of their peer groups.
- Develop a sense of their own worth and have a realistic understanding of their own strengths and weaknesses.
- Receive recognised accreditation for their achievements.

The 14-19 Curriculum builds upon and develops the knowledge existing skills and concepts acquired from previous Key stages and school settings.

The 14-19 curriculum is delivered through a subject knowledge base which provides challenging activities for the development of attitudes, concepts, knowledge and skills which will enable students to maximise future opportunities for optimum quality of life and allow them to take their place, as adults, in society in a way which is enjoyable and fulfilling.

The 14-19 curriculum provides students with opportunities for learning, not only within school, but also within a range of areas and activities within the community, including work experience. This enables students to transfer skills and attitudes to relevant and meaningful situations while at the same time broadening their experience and developing self -confidence.

The 14-19 curriculum gives students the opportunity to recognise their right make choices that affect their own life, the right to make and implement decisions, the right to determine the course of personal events and the freedom to make informed choices with the support they required.

The 14-19 curriculum provides opportunities for students to experience a range of post 19 provision. Through careers modules they will be given the opportunity to work with Connexions staff. They will visit a range local colleges and day care provision centres and be given opportunities to learn about the world of work. They will have the opportunity to access 'Taster Days' organised by local colleges and year 14 students will attend link courses at South Tyneside College.

Through the 14-19 curriculum we aim to offer experiences, which are relevant to the student's future and which enable maximum social integration and independence.
