- Additional support in class where necessary, provided by Teaching Assistants
- Individual or small group work outside of the classroom focused on learning needs, e.g. Lexia
- Access to support from relevant services, e.g. Specialist Teacher service / Pennfields Outreach
- Assessment for Access Arrangements in Summer term of Year 9 / Autumn term of Year 10

Communication and Interaction

- Language Impairment / Speech Disorder
- Autistic Spectrum Disorder

What do we offer?

- First quality teaching, to include appropriate differentiation
- Additional support in class where necessary, provided by Teaching Assistants
- Individual or small group work outside of the classroom focused on communication needs, e.g. social skills
- Access to support from relevant services, e.g. Tettenhall Outreach
- Access to support during social times, e.g. 'Drop-in club'
- Use of Social Stories / Comic Strip Conversations

Physical and / or Sensory

- Sensory Impairment, e.g. hearing / visual
- Physical Disability

What do we offer?

- First quality teaching, to include appropriate differentiation
- Additional support in class where necessary, provided by Teaching Assistants
- Individual or small group work outside of the classroom focused on specific needs, e.g. recommended exercises
- Access to support from the relevant services e.g. Sensory Inclusion Service / Penn Hall Outreach / School Nurse
- Individual Health Care Plan (IHCP) where required

- Attention Deficit Disorder
- Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder
