

TIC – Tolerance, Inclusion and Communication

For 2017/18 academic year we are partnered with five schools across Europe from France, Portugal, Spain, Cyprus and Slovenia. The aim of the project is to improve and provide opportunities for children of a variety of backgrounds, cultures and ages to collaborate by sharing ideas and experiences.

We will be focusing on how showing tolerance of others helps create a better world around them. In doing so, pupils will also learn how they can contribute through cooperation, tolerance, inclusion and communication with their everyday actions to create a better world around them.

Our project began with each school sending guess who clues each day and pupils investigating where our partner may be in the world. This developed the children's geographical skills and culture of the wider world.

Next we focused on art and design with the each respective country designing and creating their own logo focused around tolerance, inclusion and communication. To introduce the democracy aspect we then voted online for our favourite logo. The project then focused on its main object, which was to develop the children's understanding of tolerance, through studies on significant figure that shaped each respective country. This was displayed in a variety of ways (Skype calls between pupils, presentations, videobooks), this allowed the children to have a deeper understanding of the difference that individuals or groups can have on the world they live in.

Pupils will improve a range of communication skills, which will include oral, written and ICT literacy skills.
